

Retreat Covenant

- 1) What is the first and most important doctrine of the retreat? That everyone is expected to participate fully and joyfully in all activities or the retreat.
- 2) How is it that we regard the facilities we know as Pilgrim Center? The facilities used this weekend are to be cared for and respected. Any damage to property will be "charged" to the local church from whence you came. Retreat participants are expected to be in the designated areas during the regular schedule of the retreat.
- 3) What is the difference between male and female? God has created them equal but different. Males and females will be in separate cabins/rooms and should remain so.
- 4) How do we regard the "temple" of our body? We do not smoke, use drugs, or drink any alcoholic beverage.
- 5) What is the difference between day and night? God created the day for work, fun, and fellowship. The night is meant for sleeping.
- 6) How important is our eating together? Mealtimes are very important times to be together. Be prompt. Name tags should be worn.
